San Sebastian presents to us a different side of Spain, away from the corridas, siestas and flamenco dancing. On the bank of the Cantabrian Sea, this autonomous community is characterized by a fascinating culture. Here you will find the most delicious tapas in all of Spain, known here only by the name of Pintxos! In fact, San Sebastian has been experiencing a true gastronomic renaissance in recent years, making the city a top destination for its numerous Michelin star restaurants. Nearby there is the main wine region of Spain, Rioja, famous for its Tempranillo grapes.

Moving north into France, Bordeaux is renowned across the world for being the capital of a legendary wine growing region. The city itself, considered second only to Paris in terms of beauty and elegance, has a vibrant,

rich and sophisticated vibe, as well as being a top gourmet and cultural destination. Enjoy the monumental stone architecture and breathe in the true identity of Bordeaux through the unique nooks and crannies, and stop to enjoy a coffee in Place de la Bourse, one of the most beautiful squares in all of France. The city is an ideal base for exploring nearby wine regions such as Medoc, St. Emilion, Pessac-Leognan and Sauternes.

ACCOMMODATION •

Six of you will stay for 3 nights in San Sebastian and 3 nights in Bordeaux, in a boutique hotel situated in the city center with breakfast included each morning. The hotels are located near important attractions of each city. (San Sebastian: Hotel Sercotel or similar / Bordeaux: Hotel Burdigala or similar)

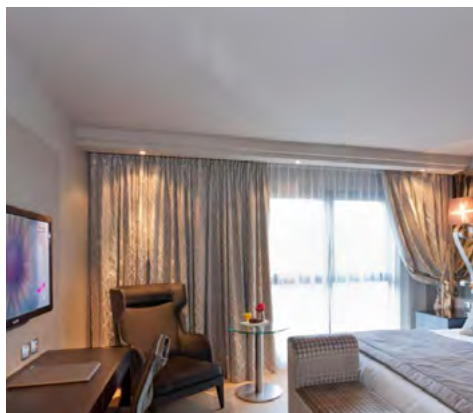
WHILE YOU ARE HERE •

The best way to experience the Old Town of San Sebastian is through a true pintxos evening. Here a local guide will take you to discover the best places for pintxos, and you will get to know the city as you walk from place to place. Then on another day, the six of you will explore the famous wine region of Spain, La Rioja, where the day will be dedicated to the “prince” of the Spanish vines, the Tempranillo. A private guide will take you for tastings and tours to 2 wine cellars with a stop in between for a traditional lunch in the medieval town of Laguardia.

A private transfer will bring you from San Sebastian to Bordeaux, one of the most fascinating wine destinations in the world. Discover the secrets of Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec and Merlot while embarking on a full day wine tour, visiting 2 cellars in the Médoc wine region. This includes a typical lunch at a restaurant and transportation with a private driver.
